Jon Ostroff, principal and founder of DivorceDoneRight and Ostroff Law, graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree from the Business School at Pennsylvania State University before earning his law degree from Delaware Law School. He was a lecturer for Penn State University and certified as an "advocate" by the National College of Advocacy. He is admitted to practice law in all of the state courts in Pennsylvania, as well as in the Eastern and Middle District of Pennsylvania Federal Courts.

As an honorary member of Mothers Against Drunk Drivers, Jon frequently lectures and provides legal counsel for this group. He is an active member in good standing with the Association of Trial Lawyers of America, the Pennsylvania Bar Association, the Montgomery County Bar Association and the American Bar Association.

Jon Ostroff has received numerous honors and awards which demonstrate the depth of his commitment to his clients and the legal profession. MADD (Mothers Against Drunk Driving) has frequently called upon Jon to be a featured speaker at various functions they have organized, recognizing his deep commitment to the victims of drunk driving crashes.

Jon was recently honored by US Supreme Court Justice Hon. Stephen Breyer and Special Master Kenneth Feinberg for the pro bono work he performed on behalf of the victims of the 9/11 tragedy. Jon actually handled the first formal 9/11 hearing in the country before Special Master Feinberg, which was on behalf of the Estate of a young woman who died on that tragic day. This case set important precedents that benefitted thousands of individuals who filed subsequent claims with the 9/11 Victims Compensation Fund. For this work, Jon was also a member of, and honored by, Trial Lawyers Care, which is the group of lawyers that led the largest pro bono effort in history following the horrific events of 9/11.

Whether it was the aftermath of 9/11 or Hurricane Katrina, where Jon, working from Biloxi, Mississippi, only days after the hurricane struck, organized relief efforts to evacuate hurricane victims who had no way out of their uninhabitable homes or town, Jon Ostroff is a lawyer with principles, one who acts and leads.

While in law school, Jon benefited from holding the prestigious position of assisting Honorable Daniel Hermann, Chief Justice of the Delaware Supreme Court. Chief Justice Herman was a pioneer in alternative dispute resolutions, which includes mediation.
